**SUBJECT: Agricultural Sales at Downtown City Lot**

**BACKGROUND**

The Council had decided to move the Farmer's Market and all daily agricultural sales to the Park n Ride lot and the adjacent overflow lot this year. One of the daily vendors has requested that agricultural sales be allowed in the downtown lot during the week. The Public Works Commission reviewed this request and felt that at this time the current arrangement was working well and no changes were needed. After the season is over the Commission felt that the Council could review the decision and decide at that time how to proceed next year. The vendor will be at the meeting to present his concerns to the Council.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends hearing the vendors concerns and deciding on either allowing agricultural sales at the downtown lot during the week or keeping things as is.
