BACKGROUND

At the June 3 regular meeting, Council adopted a resolution approving the feasibility report for the improvement of 2nd Street SW from Belle Street West to North Street West by installing streets. The resolution also called an improvement hearing for the project to be held on July 1. Unfortunately, the proper notification of the improvement hearing was not completed so another hearing must be called, and the resolution calling for a hearing on August 5 is included for approval.

This delay is only in the improvement hearing process and not the construction process for the street improvement. Separate action on this agenda is requesting adoption of a resolution ordering the plans and specifications for the project and authorizing advertising for bids.

Whereas, the report provides information regarding whether the proposed improvement is necessary, cost-effective, and feasible; whether it should best be made as proposed or in connection with some other improvement; the estimated cost of the improvement as recommended; and a description of the methodology used to calculate individual assessments for affected parcels, and

Whereas, the Council called a hearing for said proposed improvement for July 1, but proper notification of said hearing was not completed and a new hearing must be called;

- 1. The Council will consider the improvement of such areas in accordance with the report and assessment of abutting property for all or portion of the cost of the improvement pursuant to Minnesota Statues, Chapter 429 at an estimated total cost of the improvement of \$75,000.
- 2. A public hearing shall be held on such proposed improvement on the 5th day of August, 2014, in the council chambers of the city hall at 6:30 p.m. and the clerk shall give mailed and published notice of such hearing and improvement as required by law.
