**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A MONETARY GRANT FROM

WHEREAS, the Cannon Falls Ambulance Service was provided with the opportunity to apply for grant money for the purchase of cardiac monitoring equipment for the ambulance; and

WHEREAS, at times opportunities arise to obtain equipment that is new or beneficial to the ambulance service that was not anticipated for within the yearly budget; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Mission: Lifeline EMS Equipment Grant Program has provided an equipment grant , not to exceed \$25,000.00 to be used towards the purchase of cardiac monitoring equipment for the ambulance service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Cannon Falls accepts the grant from the Minnesota Mission: Lifeline EMS Equipment Grant Program, in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00, to be used towards the purchase of cardiac monitoring equipment for the ambulance. The ambulance service director is hereby authorized to execute such agreements as are necessary to implement the acceptance of this grant on behalf of the City of Cannon Falls Ambulance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Director of the City of Cannon Falls Ambulance is hereby authorized to be the fiscal agent and administer the grant on behalf of the Cannon Falls Ambulance Service.
