

BACKGROUND.

A Petition requesting the vacation of a part of Stoughton Street has been received – see the *accompanying map* that illustrates the right-of-way to be vacated. Staff have reviewed the request and feels that there is no need to retain the right-of-way to accommodate construction of a new street in this area. Prior to vacating a public street the City Council must first conduct a public hearing with 14-days published notice and 10-days mailed notice – notice has been published and mailed.
