

ENCROACHMENT AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT ("Agreement") made this ____ day of ______, 2014, by and between the CITY OF CANNON FALLS, a Minnesota municipal corporation ("City"), and DUANE H. HOLT AND JUDITH A. HOLT, husband and wife ("Landowners").

RECITALS

- A. Landowners are the fee owners of real property located at 721 Main Street West in the City of Cannon Falls, situated in Goodhue County, Minnesota, identified as PID 52.100.2630 and legally described on Exhibit"A" attached hereto ("Subject Property"):
- B. Landowners' shed encroaches on property owned by the City and legally described on Exhibit "B" attached hereto ("City Property"). Landowners seek permission from the City to encroach on the City Property.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THEIR MUTUAL COVENANTS, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- The City hereby grants Landowners permission for the shed to encroach on the City
 Property.
- 2. Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed an abandonment, vacation or waiver of the City interest in the City Property.

- 3. Landowners, for themselves, their heirs, successors and assigns, hereby agree to defend, indemnify and hold the City harmless from all costs and expenses, claims and liability, including attorney fees, relating to or arising out of the grant to Landowners of permission to encroach into the City property. Landowners further agree to indemnify and hold the City harmless from any damage caused to the Subject Property as a result of maintenance of the City property, including any damage to the residence on the Subject Property, caused in whole or part by the encroachment into the City property.
- 4. The City does not warrant title or guarantee the continuing right of Landowners to maintain the shed on the City Property.
- 5. The City may terminate this Agreement upon ninety (90) days written notice if the City determines it has a use for the City property and that the shed interferes with the use.

 Landowners may not replace the shed on the City property if it is damaged to more than fifty percent (50%) of its fair market value, as measured immediately prior to the damage.
- 6. This Agreement shall run with the land and shall be recorded against the title to the Subject Property.
