**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF A

WHEREAS, the Cannon Falls Ambulance Service was provided with a cash donation for the purchase of equipment for the ambulance; and

WHEREAS, at times opportunities arise to obtain equipment that is new or beneficial to the ambulance service that was not anticipated for within the yearly budget; and

WHEREAS, Invenergy has donated \$500.00 to be used towards the purchase of equipment for the ambulance service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Cannon Falls accepts the donation from Invenergy, in the amount of \$500.00, to be used towards the purchase of non-budgeted equipment items for the ambulance. The ambulance service director is hereby authorized to execute such agreements as are necessary to implement the acceptance of this donation on behalf of the City of Cannon Falls Ambulance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Director of the City of Cannon Falls Ambulance is hereby authorized to be the fiscal agent and administer the donation on behalf of the Cannon Falls Ambulance Service.
