**BACKGROUND.**

Since MnDOT first installed "Frontage Road" signs at the intersections of Goodhue County Boulevard 24 with Fourth Street South and 63<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, numerous questions and complaints have been heard. The Chamber Board has considered this matter and recommends that the "Frontage Road" signs be removed and replaced with signs that identify *Fourth Street South* and *63<sup>rd</sup> Avenue* – see the accompanying map.

**REQUESTED COUNCIL ACTION.**

As recommended by the Chamber Board, the City Council is asked to approve the Resolution that requests MnDOT to remove and replace the "Frontage Road" signs with new signs that identify the actual street names.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT OF  
FRONTAGE ROAD SIGNS**

WHEREAS, in conjunction with construction of the new Highway 52 interchange and Goodhue County 24 Boulevard projects the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) determined and placed signage at various locations; and

WHEREAS, in response to public concerns citing confusion created by the “Frontage Road” signs that MnDOT installed at the intersections of Goodhue County 24 with Fourth Street South and 63<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, the Board of Directors for the Cannon Falls Area Chamber of Commerce recommends that the “Frontage Road” signs be removed and replaced with signs that identify the actual name of the connecting streets.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CANNON FALLS, MINNESOTA that a request be made to MnDOT to remove the “Frontage Road” signs as recommended by the Board of Directors for the Cannon Falls Area Chamber of Commerce and that these signs be replaced with signs that identify Fourth Street South and 63<sup>rd</sup> Avenue as depicted on the attached map.

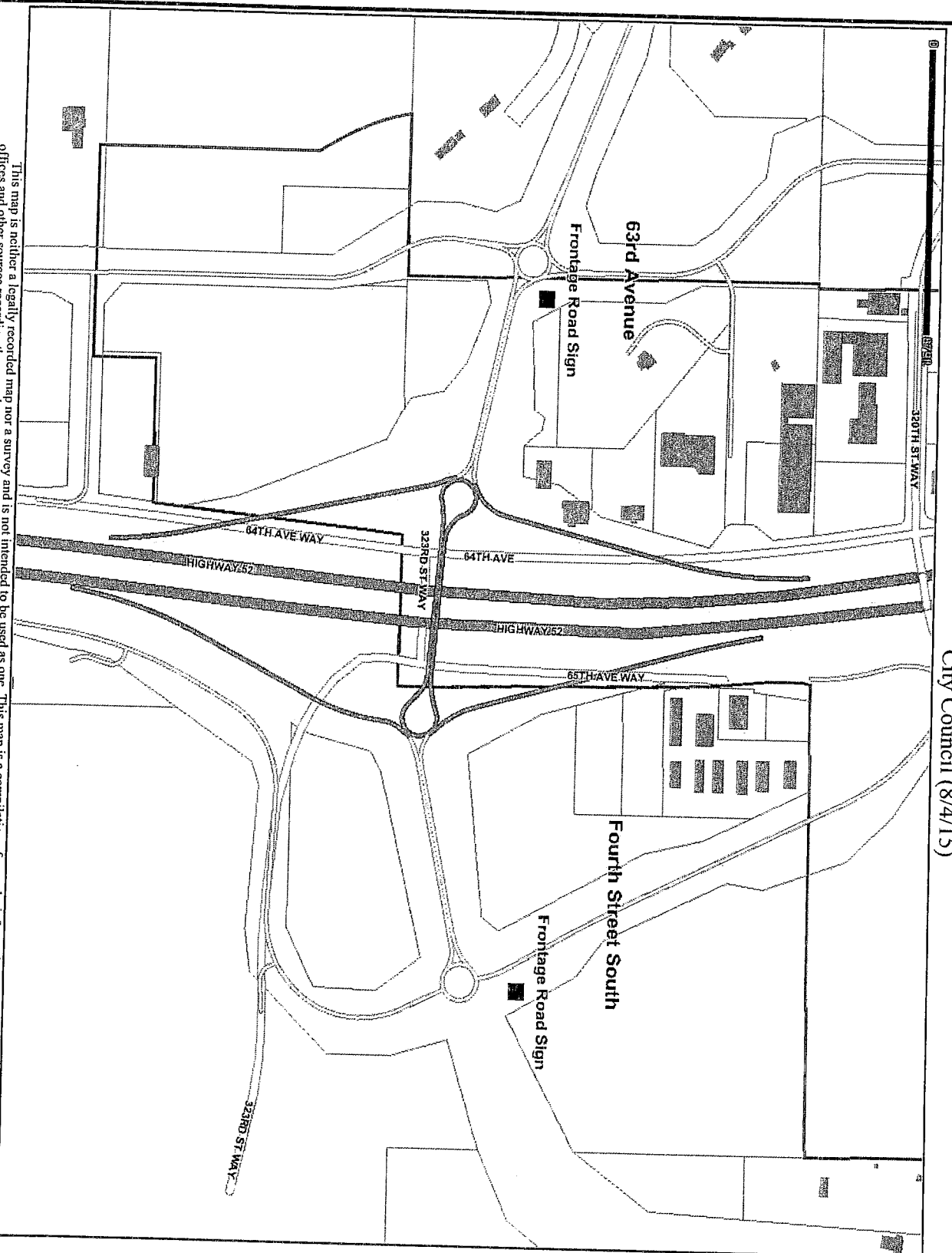
