Since MnDOT first installed "Frontage Road" signs at the intersections of Goodhue County Boulevard 24 with Fourth Street South and 63rd Avenue, numerous questions and complaints have been heard. The Chamber Board has considered this matter and recommends that the "Frontage Road" signs be removed and replaced with signs that identify *Fourth Street South* and 63rd Avenue – see the accompanying map.
