**BACKGROUND**

The Cannon Falls Police Department has been selected to receive the Outstanding Agency equipment award from the Minnesota Department of Public Safety, Office of Traffic Safety division for the second quarter of the *Toward Zero Deaths* (TZD) Enforcement grant. This new award is part of the Agency Recognition Project that replaces previous recognition programs. Our agency was nominated by Scott McConkey, the Southern Minnesota Law Enforcement Liaison and approved by the Department of Public Safety/Office of Traffic Safety. I chose to receive a Stalker LIDAR XLR to replace the LIDAR that was here when I came eight years ago. As it turned out, the timing was perfect, as the existing LIDAR has ceased to be operational.
