**SUBJECT: Dolan Sewer Credit**

## **BACKGROUND**

In January, after the December 2016 readings had been collected, Aftin noticed a significant increase in a residential property. She contacted the homeowner and they arranged for a family member to meet one of our employees at the home. Upon arriving at the home, Wes could hear water running while he was standing outside of the home. They determined that the leak was underneath a part of the home that did not have a crawl space or access to the pipes. They decided to turn the water off until the leak could be fixed. The leak began sometime in December 2016 and we shut the water off on 1/3/17. The sewer charges added up to \$3,498.74.

After following our crediting procedure, we came up with a total credit of \$3,292.38. This was reviewed by the Public Works Commission and they recommend crediting for the leak that didn't enter the sewer system per the City policy.
