
SUBJECT: MnDOT Signage.

BACKGROUND.

Since MnDOT completed the new interchange and roundabouts, frequent complaints have been heard relating to MnDOT's signage. On July 13th representatives of MnDOT, Cannon Falls Township, Goodhue County, Cannon Falls and David Olson met to discuss signage and matters relating to jurisdictional considerations. This meeting produced a somewhat surprising outcome with MnDOT staff agreeing to support and pay for installation of diagrammatic and exit signage for Cannon Falls. The proposed agreement required approval by MnDOT District 6 Management and now by the City of Cannon Falls.

REQUESTED COUNCIL ACTION.

At MnDOT's request, the City Council is asked to approve placement of new "diagrammatic" and "exit" signs in locations determined by MnDOT – the proposed sign designs accompany this Memorandum. Placement of the proposed signs has been recommended by local business/property owners that have expressed concerns relating to the ineffectiveness and confusion created by the existing signs.
