SUBJECT: ESTABLISHING COMBINATION LIQUOR LICENSE FEES
MEETING DATE: MAY 15, 2018

BACKGROUND

The City Council recently amended an ordinance of the City Code to allow the issuance of a combination off-sale and on-sale intoxicating license to the same licensee in lieu of issuing separate licenses. The City needs to establish the license fees for the combination liquor licenses. A public hearing is required to be held to allow for input in setting the fee amounts.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff has discussed the issue and suggests the following:

Beer/Wine On-Sale & Off-Sale	\$1,250
Full Liquor On-Sale & Off Sale	\$2,950

These fees reflect the total of the separate license fees. Also, Sunday liquor sales are allowed with a separate license and that fee would apply if the applicant chooses to offer Sunday liquor sales.

REQUESTED COUNCIL ACTION

Adopt the resolution establishing the combination liquor license fees.

**A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH LICENSE FEE FOR
