SUBJECT: ELECTION JUDGES FOR 2018 PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTIONS

MEETING DATE: JUNE 19, 2018

BACKGROUND

The 2018 Primary and General Elections will be held in August and November respectively. The City is required to appoint election judges that will be used for those elections. The election judges will be selected from Exhibit A which is attached to the proposed resolution. Election judges must meet certain criteria in order to be eligible to serve. Staff will select from the list those that meet the requirements.

Due to recent minimum wage law adjustments, we reviewed the hourly wages paid to the election judges. The wages for the judges have not been adjusted for over ten years and I am recommending we increase the hourly wages as follows: Head Judges from \$12.80 to \$13.20 and Election Judges from \$9.60 to \$10.00. The additional cost for training, health care outreach and both elections is estimated to be \$300.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends adopting the resolution appointing the election judges for the 2018 elections and increasing the hourly wages.

REQUESTED COUNCIL ACTION

Staff respectfully requests the Council to adopt the resolution appointing election judges for the 2018 Primary and General Elections and increasing the hourly wages.

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING PRIMARY AND GENERAL ELECTION JUDGES FOR 2018 AND SETTING THE HOURLY WAGES

Head Judges \$13.20 Election Judges \$10.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Cannon Falls that the names listed on Exhibit A, hereto attached, are the official Election Judges for the City of Cannon Falls, for the August 14, 2018 Primary Election and November 6, 2018 General Election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Council of the City of Cannon Falls, does hereby allow the Elections Administrator or City Administrator to make substitutions to the attached slate of judges as necessary to fill vacancies and to meet and maintain eligibility and party affiliation requirements.

BE IT ALSO FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Council of the City of Cannon Falls sets the hourly wages for the Head Judges to be \$13.20 and Election Judges to be \$10.00.
