SUBJECT: Sale of Rescue Truck

BACKGROUND

We are currently expecting delivery of our new rescue truck in early September. With the receipt of the new apparatus, we no longer have a need for the old one. I have spoken with Wes Anway, Interim Public Works Director, about a need for keeping the apparatus for use in public works. I showed him the vehicle and he did not feel they had a need for it at this time. We believe selling the vehicle is our best option. Brindlee Mountain Fire Apparatus is a national vendor that would advertise and assist with the sale of this apparatus. The sale of the truck will be contingent upon delivery of the new apparatus so there will not be an interruption of services. The list price would be \$30,000.00, with a minimum bid price in mind which I would rather not make public at this time. The sale would be "as is" condition. This agreement comes with a ten percent seller's fee. Delivery costs would be the buyer's responsibility. We also have the option to still advertise the truck locally and void the contract, at no cost to the City, if we sell the truck on our own. I will mention it at our local Chief's meeting to see if any local departments are interested and advertise on our Fire Dept. Facebook Page. I would like to sell without further council approval if we get an offer above the minimum dollar amount.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

I request authorization to sell the 1996 International Marion built Rescue Truck and recommend accepting the Brindlee Mountain Sale Agreement to advertise for the sale of this vehicle on a national level and sell the truck on our behalf or to sell it locally to the highest bidder, whichever comes first.
