

The Cannon Falls City Council met in a work session on Tuesday, March 19, 2019 at 7:15 p.m. in the City Council Chambers. Present were Mayor John Althoff, Council Members Mary Jill Bringgold, Bill Duncan, Steve Gesme, Derek Lundell, Morris Mattson and Matt Montgomery. Also present were City Administrator David Maroney, Public Works Director/Fire Chief Mike Althoff, EMS Chief Tim Malchow, Library Director Nicole Miller, Police Chief Jeff McCormick, Police Lieutenant Joe Berg, Cable Director Mike Gesme and Zoning Assistant Samantha Pierret.

Purpose The purpose of the work session was to discuss and prioritize goals for 2019 and beyond.

Discussion Similar to the format used to identify goals, the council and staff were split into two groups for small group discussions and assigned the task of prioritizing goals that were identified on March 5th. The forty-one (41) goals and ideas that the two groups first identified were categorized by Staff as goals pertaining to either public finance/services/facilities; community planning and development; internal operations; or external operations. After approximately thirty (30) minutes of small group discussion the two groups gathered to discuss and present their priority goals.

City Administrator Maroney and Zoning Assistant Pierret compared the list of goals identified by each group. Following discussion and input from the participants, two (2) goals were identified for each of the three (3) categories (public finance/service/facilities; community planning and development; and internal and external operations). City Administrator Maroney will prepare the list of priority goals for final review by the City Council on April 2, 2019.

Adjournment The meeting was duly adjourned at approximately 8:45 p.m.
