**BACKGROUND**

The Cannon Valley Fair has used a Strawberry ride display to promote the fair in past years. For 2019 a request had been made to park the Strawberry on the Street in front of Althoff's Hardware for the month of June. Althoff's Hardware was spoken with regarding this request and is in favor of this, because they are the sales location for tickets and wristbands for the fair. In the past the Fair has done this, but have moved the trailer daily, which required a lot of additional time. It has been requested to park the trailer with the Strawberry and trailer (the plan is to use a smaller trailer) and not have to move it daily. Because there is a 24 hour limit on a parked vehicle, City Council action to allow this request is needed. The Public Works Commission discussed this request at the April 10, 2019 meeting. The Public Works Commission voted to approve the request.
