**RESOLUTION VACATING PLATTED STREET AND ALLEYWAY IN  
THE CITY OF CANNON FALLS**

WHEREAS, it has been proposed to vacate part of an existing platted street and alleyway; and

WHEREAS, following duly given notice, the City Council of Cannon Falls has held a public hearing and considered comments and objections thereto and found that the vacation of said platted street and alleyway is in the public interest.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CANNON FALLS, GOODHUE COUNTY, MINNESOTA, that the following described platted street and alleyway is hereby vacated:

The platted sixteen (16) foot wide and three hundred (300) foot long alleyway separating Block 1 Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Schmidt Addition and the single parcel in Block 56 and the Southern ½ of Block 55 of the Original Plat of the City of Cannon Falls AND the platted eighty (80) foot wide and three hundred (300) foot long section of Colvill Street running east to west on Block 56 and the Southern ½ of Block 55 Original Plat of the City of Cannon Falls.
