BACKGROUND.

For nearly 3-years Staff has been working with the property owner at 810 Mill Street to permit and complete construction of an off-street parking stall in the front yard. On March 1, 2019, I sent a letter to the owner stipulating that the stall needed to be completed by June 1, 2019 or the City would take action to remove the existing concrete apron that lies within the Mill Street right-of-way. Removal of the apron would prevent connection of the private parking stall to Mill Street. The stall was not completed by June 1st so we discussed and agreed that if the earth work, site preparation and framing was completed by June 9th and the concrete installed by June 30th that I would support one final extension. The site work was neither begun nor completed by June 9th. On June 10th the property owner and I discussed the situation again and I was informed that they were no longer interested in pursuing or constructing the parking stall.

REQUESTED COUNCIL ACTION.

As recommended by the Public Works Commission, the City Council is asked to approve the accompanying Resolution which authorizes removal of the concrete apron and installation of concrete curb in its place.
