

Through SMIF's Communities Addressing the Child Care Shortage program, five communities throughout the region are receiving one-on-one technical assistance to think creatively about how to add quality slots. The City of Wells has created two initiatives through this program: a forgivable loan program and a space that family child care providers can rent to run their child care business.

Many business owners in small communities are beginning to think about retirement, and in order to keep those businesses strong and growing, they need to have a succession plan. With the support of a \$20,000 Economic Development Grant from SMIF, BizLink North created an online website where entrepreneurs looking to move on from business ownership are connected to potential buyers.

SMIF can't be everywhere, so we are determined to empower our communities by acting as the fiscal host to 30 community foundations. These foundations annually grant out over \$600,000 to local projects. For example, the St. Charles Area Community Foundation has helped transform a vacant lot into a functional community gathering space.
