WHEREAS, the Cannon Falls Fire Department Relief Association has donated to the Fire Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Cannon Falls accepts the donation from the Cannon Falls Fire Relief Association, in the amount of \$2,500.00, to be used towards the cost difference of a new boat and to cover pick up expenses for said new boat for the Cannon Falls Fire Department. The Fire Chief is hereby authorized to execute such agreements as are necessary to implement the acceptance of this donation on behalf of the City of Cannon Falls Fire Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fire Chief of the City of Cannon Falls is hereby authorized to be the fiscal agent and administer the donation on behalf of the Cannon Falls Fire Department.
