BACKGROUND

The 2020 Primary and General elections will be held on August 11, 2020 and November 3, 2020. The City is required to appoint election judges that will be used for any election. The election judges will be selected from Exhibit A which is attached to the proposed resolution. Election judges must meet certain criteria in order to be eligible to serve. Staff will select from the list those that meet the requirements.

The Council will also be asked to approve wages for the election judges. Staff has reviewed the wages and are proposing to increase the wages to be comparable to other cities within the County.

Staff respectfully requests the Council to adopt the resolution appointing election judges for the 2020 Primary and General elections and approving the hourly wages for election judges.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Council of the City of Cannon Falls, does hereby allow the Elections Administrator or City Administrator to make substitutions to the attached slate of judges as necessary to fill vacancies and to meet and maintain eligibility and party affiliation requirements.

BE IT ALSO FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Council of the City of Cannon Falls sets the hourly wages for the Election Judges to be \$15.00.
