## ORDINANCE NUMBER 370 SECOND SERIES

#### AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A POLICE COMMISSION

#### THE CITY OF CANNON FALLS ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1</u>. **Establishment and composition.** A Police commission of the City of Cannon Falls is hereby established.

<u>Section 2.</u> Membership. The Board shall be composed of six (6) members total, all appointed by the City Council. The membership includes three (3) Cannon Falls Residents, two (2) members of the City Council and the mayor.

#### **Section 3. Duties.** The Police Commission duties are as follows:

- (A) Recommend the hire of Police Chief and Officers;
- (B) To assist the council in planning and research in the area of police matters, including budget, equipment, manpower, inter-governmental cooperation, and public information programs;
- (C) Take under advisement, study, hold meetings and make their written recommendations to the Mayor / City Council on all other police or police related matters referred to them by staff or City Council;
- (D) The Commission shall not have jurisdiction over the employment, promotion, discharge, or suspension of Police Department employees;
  - (E) Members shall serve on staggered 3-year terms;
  - (F) Police Commission will meet quarterly or as needed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.
