# BACKGROUND

The Minnesota Supreme Court released the new congressional and legislature redistricting plans. As a part of that process, Minnesota Statute 204B.14, subd. 3(e) requires that all precinct boundaries be established or reestablished. Even though the City of Cannon Falls did not see any changes to the precinct boundaries as a result of the redistricting, we are still required to reestablish our existing boundaries and the polling place. Therefore, a resolution is attached for your consideration.

## A RESOLUTION REESTABLISHING PRECINCTS & POLLING PLACES

WHEREAS, the legislature of the State of Minnesota has been redistricted; and

**WHEREAS**, Minnesota Statute section 204B.14 Subd. 3(e) requires that precinct boundaries must be reestablished within 60 days of when the legislature has been redistricted or at least 19 weeks before the state primary election, whichever comes first;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of Cannon Falls, Minnesota hereby reestablishes the boundaries of the voting precincts and polling places as follows:

# Precinct (Ward) 1 (City Hall/Government Center, 918 River Road)

The part of the city lying south of the Cannon River and Little Cannon River

# Precinct (Ward) 2 (City Hall/Government Center, 918 River Road)

The part of the city lying north of the Cannon River and Little Cannon River
