SUBJECT: Painting Project

BACKGROUND

Since receiving the donation to the fire department from the Drometer Estate, we have been looking at a purposeful way to spent those funds. One project we have identified is installing gear lockers to accommodate both fire and EMS in the apparatus garage. The lockers are mounted to the wall. I would like to paint the apparatus bay before this is done. Sections of the station haven't been painted for over 25 years. We received \$12,500 last month from Goodhue County for training reimbursement and site rent. We train with Minnesota Homeland Security and Emergency Management to be a decontamination site for the nuclear power plant in the event of an emergency there. We also store equipment for this detail at our station. I would like to use these funds to repaint the inside of the apparatus bay before installing new lockers later this winter.

I received two bids:

Johnson Painting, \$15,480

Michael Wojahn Paining, \$10,400

Both bids are for painting the lower 8 feet of the interior walls with a grey epoxy, and upper portions in an enamel white.
