- A complimentary service for your recyclables
- Source separated recycling (that's you!)
- Expanded recycling options beyond plastic, aluminum and cardboard

Source Separated Recycling?

- YOU bring your recyclables to us already separated into:
 - Plastic (PET(E) HDPE) ONLY
 - Metal: tin and aluminum
 - Clear glass bottles & jars ONLY
 - Brown glass bottles & jars ONLY
 - Green glass bottles & jars ONLY
 - Newspapers, including inserts
 - Cardboard
 - Magazines

Expanded Recycling Options?

- The Goodhue County Recycling Center offers additional recycling options:
 - Used oil and oil filter disposal for residents
 - Used, clean & dry clothing
 - Office paper
 - Fluorescent bulbs
 - Batteries; <u>excluding:</u> Alkaline and Heavy Duty batteries


