BACKGROUND

The Cannon Valley Trail Joint Powers Board has approved applying for a Greater Minnesota Regional Parks and Trails Commission grant to replace one bridge and 4.5 miles of bituminous.

The total project cost is \$1,934,240 and the CVT will provide a 25% match of \$483,560. The CVT has the funds to cover the \$483, 560. No funds are being requested from the City of Cannon Falls to complete this project.

Goodhue County will be the applicant of this grant because they own the CVT property. Since the CVT is operated by a Joint Powers Board, the grant application is requesting the remaining two units of government (Cannon Falls and Red Wing) approve a resolution which supports the grant application.
