SUBJECT: WAYFINDING SIGNAGE FOR CITY OF CANNON FALLS TRAIL SYSTEM

DATE: FEBRUARY 18, 2025

BACKGROUND.

The City is in dire need of adding and updating the wayfinding signage at certain areas along the city trail system. There are areas where visitors coming from the Cannon Valley Trail are left with no navigation as to where they can find their connection to the next trail access or back to the trail head. Signage that does exist is about 20 years old and the posts are rotting, paint is peeling and overall, they look outdated.

In a collaborative effort to replace and update the signage, the Chamber and EDA have uncovered two grants that could potentially fund the replacement of the signs if authored successfully. The plan is to acquire the Goodhue County grant and use that plus the Public Works labor for installation as the 50% match toward the Taylor Family Farm Foundation grant. If only one is awarded, the signage order will be modified to fit the amount awarded.

- 1. Goodhue County Community Partner Award -- 10% match required can be Public Works installation; Grant fund maximum \$5,000
- 2. Taylor Family Farms Foundation -- 50% match required; Grant fund \$10-\$50,000.

The signage company that has created the new park signs gave a quote for the wayfinding signs of \$6,740 which would include 2 large signs indicating Downtown Destinations, Mill Towns State Trail, Goodhue County Lake Byllesby Park and Dakota County Regional Park; a sign indicating CVT, MTST, and Lake Byllesby Trail; and also 2 small individual Trail Head signs.

These signs have a graffiti resistant coating on them, a 10 year warranty and are weather resistant for MN.


Wilson and Qualey presented to the Public Works and Park Board on Feb. 6th and the Commissioners unanimously recommended moving forward with applying for the grants.

Staff respectfully requests a motion from the Council to approve submission of the Goodhue County Community Partner Award and the Taylor Family Farms Foundation to purchase wayfinding signage for the city trail system.

- Time to update




Purpose of Wayfinding Signage

- E. 3rd Street and Water Street




