RE: Lead Service Line Replacement

In January this year, the City received a grant for \$1,000,000. The grant will be used to replace approximately 40 Lead and Galvanized water services. This is a continuation of the work to identify lead water service lines that started in 2024.

Attached to this memo is a resolution from the Minnesota Public Facility Authority (PFA) required to complete the funding approval process. Once the funding has been finalized WHKS will produce bid documents to publicly bid the service line replacements. We anticipate construction will occur in the fall of 2026 and into the spring of 2027

The City has recently submitted another application for additional funding for 2027.

**A RESOLUTION OF APPLICATION FOR DRINKING WATER STATE REVOLVING
FUND PROGRAM – LEAD SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT**

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Cannon Falls is hereby applying to the Minnesota Public Facilities Authority for a loan and/or grant from the Drinking Water Revolving Fund for a lead service line replacement project, 2026 Project Priority List Project IS 1250001-8, as described in the application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Cannon Falls estimates the MPFA-Financed amount to be \$1,000,000 or the as-bid cost of the project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of Cannon Falls has the legal authority to apply for the loan and/or grant, and the financial, technical, and managerial capacity to repay the loan and ensure proper construction, operation and maintenance of the project for its design life.
