SUBJECT: Winery Fall Festival Alley Closure

DATE: September 15, 2016

BACKGROUND

The Winery is planning a Fall Festival for October 29, 2016 between music from 7:30-10:30pm. They have requested to close part of the alley between Main Street (Hwy 19) and Mill Street from 4pm until 11pm to allow for setup, event and take down. The request allows the Winery Property to be connected with the old Lee Chevrolet property that they lease from the EDA and enclosed (see attached drawing). The connection would also provide additional seating area from the music stage they are planning on the leased property. This closure is similar the veteran's lane closures that have been approved for VFW events.

As in the past the Police Department and Public Works will work with the event coordinator to find a balance between the safety of the event attendees and the impact on the residents and businesses effected by the closure.
